Studebaker Museum Tour Special Edition

Join fellow club members on October 26, 2013 at the **Studebaker National Museum** in South Bend, Indiana, followed by dinner at **Tippycanoe Place**, a restaurant in the former home of the Studebaker family. Dinner is planned for 5 PM.



Museum staff suggest a self paced experience at the Studebaker Museum will last about two hours,

while a visit to the Center for History and a guided tour of the Oliver Mansion can be completed in about one and one-half hours.

In addition to the Studebaker Museum, the Center for History, a regional interest museum, is located in an adjoining wing and tours are available of the adjacent Oliver home, the 38 room mansion of industrialist J.D. Oliver.

Tippycanoe Place is only a few minutes from the museum campus, known as The Museums at Washington and Chapin.

Participants may choose their travel route and are encouraged to arrive at the museum campus by 1:30 p.m. Off street

parking is available on site. Saturday hours at the museums are 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

South Bend is about a one hour drive from Kalamazoo, and about two hours from Grand Rapids.

Per person admission to the Studebaker Museum is \$6.50 while combined admission to Studebaker and the Center for History is \$10 for our group.

Dinner at Tippycanoe is from their regular menu and the per-person cost will be about \$25.00, plus

extras. The Western Michigan Section is not charging a club registration fee for this event.
