DEUTSCHEMARQUES 2022

The Western Michigan Section of MBCA was one of five German car clubs participating in this year's tenth annual DeutscheMarques at the Gilmore Car Museum in Hickory Corners, Michigan. DeutscheMarques is one of the largest all-German car shows in the United States. This year's show attracted 535 registered cars, a 7% increase over last year's number. Mercedes-Benz registered cars numbered 75, this is a 10% increase over last year. Highlighting the Mercedes-Benz cars was a replica of the 1886 Benz Motorwagen, courtesy of the Gilmore Car Museum, and a 1938 540K, courtesy of Bill Parfet, the chairman of the board at the Gilmore. Five MBCA sections were represented at the show.

On Friday evening preceding DeutscheMarques, the Western Michigan section hosted a dinner at Four Roses, a local restaurant, for those visiting from other sections and our own members. Over twenty Mercedes owners had a great time. We are hoping more will be able to join us next year.

THE MERCEDES-BENZ CLUB OF AMERICA PRESENTS THE INAUGURAL MBCA NATIONAL MEDALLION RALLY

AUGUST 26-OCTOBER 26, 2022

WHAT IS THE MEDALLION RALLY?

The Medallion Rally is a first ever event of its kind sponsored by the Mercedes Benz Club of America (MBCA).

The purpose of the rally is to unite all 84 Sections of the MBCA in North America in a national event that links each Section by the passing of medallions between Sections and area Alzheimer Affiliates until all are symbolically connected through the passing and receiving of the medallions, and in the process raise funds annually the Alzheimer's Association.

The Rally Medallion's are being sold for \$100 each. All MBCA Sections are to use the sales of Medallions as a means to fundraise for the Alzheimer's Association. Prizes will be awarded to the top three fundraising Sections based on the amount of funds they raise on behalf of the Alzheimer's Association.

Medallion's are collector items for members, with a new medallion being created each year.

Each of the 84 sections of the Mercedes-Benz Club are invited to participate in the Medallion Rally. All sections and their members exist in close proximity to an Alzheimer's Association of America Chapter Office, or in close proximity to Alzheimer's Association field personnel.

There is a Mercedes-Benz Club of America Medallion Rally Landing Page on the MBCA website (mbca.org) where an individual can order their medallion(s). The medallions will be sent directly to the purchaser and all of the transactions for the medallions are managed by a third party that will process the order, fulfill the order, and provide all of the data on all transactions to each MBCA section at the end of the fund raiser.

Each of the 84 Sections of the MBCA can also purchase a unique medallion(s) with that sections name engraved on it, it is referred to as the Team Medallion. For their \$100 donation the Section will actually receive two (2) Team Medallions.

The Medallion Rally began August 26, 2022 and will end in October at the Mercedes Benz Club of America National Convention, "Mercedes Freude" in Newport Beach, California.

Prizes will be awarded the top three section fundraisers and a Section of the Year will be awarded to the club that exhibits the most exuberance, promotion, and fund raising ideas and efforts. The intent is for the Medallion Rally to become an annual event on behalf of the entire MBCA.

HOW THE FUNDRAISER & RALLY WORK

Each member has the opportunity to purchase a collector medallion for \$100. Each medallion purchased allows the member to enter their car in the Medallion Rally and be a part of the caravan and drive to a designated meeting site hosted by the area or local Alzheimers Association Staff and Volunteers. When the exchange happens, the MBCA Section hands off one of their two (2) team Medallions to Alzheimer's Representatives representing their section's geographic area. This process continues across the country until all 84 MBCA Sections have presented their Team Medallion to 84 corresponding Alzheimer's Association Chapter.

Once the section has presented one of their Team Medallions to the Alzheimer's representatives, the Section takes their second Team Medallion and sends it to a designated address where the Team Medallions will be collected and stored until all 84 Sections have been accounted for with their participation. These 84 collected Team Medallions from each of the 84 Sections will be taken to the National Convention to be presented to the Board of Directors of the MBCA signifying all 84 Sections participation and contribution.

A check for the total amount raised will be presented to Alzheimer's representatives at our National Event.
